#### **Key Functions (2)**



- Informing negotiating positions
  NECD 2020, CLRTAP GP, POPs, HM
- Continuous improvement
  Biomass/biofuels, metals, shipping, uncertainty
- Informing the public
  Public, private sector and academia



#### Review and new contract (1)



- Spring 2008 independent review of contract
- Process of commissioning; meeting the requirements of users; the quality of scientific output; future requirements
- Output is fully satisfactory; work of the current contractor is well-regarded; contract appears to continue to offer good value for money
- Suggestions for future work areas



#### Review and new contract (2)



- Contract is re-commissioned with the current contractor or a wider consortium
- New contract with AEA Energy & Environment as lead contractor – Oct 2008
- Three year contract



#### **Future challenges**

- Improvements to the inventory
  - PM<sub>2.5</sub>, ammonia
  - Biomass, shipping, small comb. plants, local data
- International engagement
- Streamlining
